As I enter the final few months of my first term as CDG president I have come to realize that the recognition at both the National Conference and the Main Street Iowa Awards was nice, yes, but honestly the day-to-day work here in our own communities is far more gratifying than a photo opportunity at an awards ceremony.

I have so enjoyed this work and am proud of our many accomplishments this year, including:

- Unveiling the Hilltop Pocket Park in Uptown Mount Vernon

- Watching our volunteer team takeover and coordinate a successful Heritage Days as CDG's new-to-us event in July of 2022.



# 2022 FINANCIALS







The mission of the CDG is to develop and promote our business environment, including but not limited to our Main Street District, and enhance the quality of life in the communities we serve.

The mission of the CCDG is to advance the economic, cultural, artistic and recreational vitality of the Mount Vernon and Lisbon communities and to support the activities of the CDG in projects that enhance the quality of life in our communities.

The Mount Vernon-Lisbon Community Development Group uses the Main Street four-point approach of standing committees:

**Economic Vitality Committee** focuses on strengthening local businesses, supporting short- and long-term economic growth, and revitalizing the business districts.

**Design Committee** is involved with the physical aspects of the communities including signage, lighting, streetscapes, historic preservation and the formation of a comprehensive look and feel in our downtown districts.

**Organization Committee** focuses on communications, fundraising and volunteer recruitment.

**Promotion Committee** focuses on organizing community events, and retail development. Many events and promotions are complementary, and all advance the mission of Main Street and the CDG.

After years of planning and consideration, **unveiled Hilltop Pocket Park** in July, after the final signage, tables, chairs and artwork had been installed, completing a joint City of Mount Vernon, CDG, Mount Vernon Area Arts Council, community project

Flew six members of the CDG volunteer board to Richmond, Va., to be part of the National Main Street Conference where we received accolades as one of the Top Eight programs in the nation

# 2022 ACCOMPLISHMENTS

Facilitated a Main Street Iowa-led inventory of the 12-block area that is the Mount Vernon Main Street District. The inventory included the following statistics for 2022:

In the 12-block area that is the Mount Vernon Main Street District, there are 50 commercial buildings, 25 houses, three apartment buildings, three city-owned buildings, two churches, two church support buildings, one business incubator and one post office.

# **ADDITIONAL INITIATIVES**

- The CDG GAMSA (Great American Main Street Award) Committee has met three times since returning from Richmond, Va. and has created a work plan to apply again for the national GAMSA Award for 2024
- The volunteer CDG Marketing/Promotions committee is in the process
  of a large website redesign for 2023, which will mean a complete
  revamp of the current site. Volunteer Lisa Lansing from Lynch Ford
  Chevrolet has led this project since its inception and has agreed to stay
  on until the project is completed, expected completion date spring/
  summer of 2023.
- Talks have begun within CDG's Organization Committee on developing
  a Diversity, Equity and Inclusion (DEI) Statement that can be
  implemented by the end of 2023.
- A volunteer CDG subcommittee is involved in transforming our old "Community Cash" paper gift certificates into a plastic card system through the Economic Vitality Committee. This will be an Economic Driver and could have a huge influence on several businesses' bottom lines.
